

Mother called Usman for salah but he was in a haze of sleep and could not open his eyes. Mother came to his bed and said, "Wake up my son! It's time for salah. Look out there. How lovely breeze it is! Little sparrows are busy in praising Allah. Every animal and bird praise Allah early in the morning. Come on, leave your bed and go for salah." Usman was sleepy. He hid his face under the sheet and said, "Don't disturb me please. I am sleeping."

"My son" mother said, "Satan is misguiding you now. He is the worst enemy of us. Allah Almighty commands us to offer salah of Fajr but Satan does not want you pray and enter the paradise. Satan wants to see the children engaged in quarreling, disobeying their parents and walking on the path that leads to hell."

Usman opened his eyes with a great difficulty and said, "Mother, I want to get up for salah but the heavy burden of sleep confines me."

Mother kissed his cheek and said, "Drive the Satan away; you will get up easily." Usman got surprised to hear this, he thought it was impossible to drive the Satan away. He said, "He is so dangerous. How can I get rid of him?" Mother said, "My son! I tell you an easy way to rid him off. When some ill thought comes to your mind you should say: اَعُودُ إِللّٰهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطُ وِالرَّحِيْمِ (A'ūżu Billāhi Minash-Shayṭānir-Rajīm) Usman immediately said اَعُودُ إِللّٰهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطُ وِالرَّحِيْمِ he became alert instantly and jumped out to make ablution (Wudu). He

offered Fajr prayer and came back to his mother who was reciting the Holy Qur'an. Having stopped the recitation she kissed the Holy book and touched with her eyes. Usman said, "Mother! You never kissed my school books; however you kissed and touched the Holy Qur'an with your eyes?" Mother said, "My son! This is not an ordinary book but a Holy script of Allah. Allah Almighty has descended this last of His books upon our beloved Prophet so we pay extraordinary regard to Holy Qur'an. It is a sign of our devotion. Moreover, we do not turn our back to Holy Qur'an and make ablution before touching it. It is recommended to say منافظي الأولية والأولية والأولي

Usman recalled something and he said in excitement, "Mother! You told me to recite بِسُوللُولِوَ before eating and doing my home work as well." Mother was glad to hear this. She said, "Very good, we should say before doing any good activity to seek blessing." Mother began to recite the Holy Qur'an again. Usman was completely absorbed in the sweet recitation of Holy verses by his mother.

Later he asked, "Mother, in which language is the Holy Qur'an written? I did not understand its meaning while I was listening to the recitation. But it was so sweet."

Mother told Usman, "The Holy Qur'an is in Arabic language and it has thirty parts (Paras). Usman kept all these points safe in his mind and further he asked, "You said that the Holy Qur'an is the last of His books. Which ones were descended before this?"



when you are home. Why do you go to office daily?


Just stay home with me, please."

should also say بِسُواللَّهِ الرَّحُمْنِ الرَّحِينِ while stepping out of the home." Sajid began to say بِسُواللَّهِ الرَّحَمْنِ الرَّحِينِ before leaving for school and he stopped getting scared of the forest because he knew that angels protect him.



One day he asked his mother, "Who are angels?" Mother said, "Angels are the servants of Allah Almighty. Allah has made them from light (Nur)."

Note for the teacher: Explain in plain words the initial information about Angels to the students. There are many creations of Allah we can not see e.g. air, fragrance etc.


Paradise and Hell


